WE RESPECT EACH OTHER BY:

- Accepting different cultural and religious views.
- **Learning from** each other's different life experiences.
- **Being careful** about what we say. Share our opinions, but do not make negative comments about someone else's opinions.
- Asking before taking photos or posting photos on the internet.
- **Being careful about touching** each other. In some societies this is not acceptable, especially a member of the opposite sex.
- Taking care especially of students under 18 years old.

WE DON'T USE UNKIND ACTIONS OR WORDS (bullying, abuse or harassment).

This includes:

- Hurting others by actions or words
- Making unwanted sexual suggestions
- Saying negative things about an individual's sex, age, religion, sexual orientation, disability or culture
- Destroying, damaging, or hiding property
- Promoting or spreading extremist views

YOU SHOULD:

If you see any bad behaviour, you should tell your teacher or another member of staff.

Anyone who hurts others will be investigated under the **Discipline**, **Exclusion and Complaints Policy** or the **Safeguarding Policy**.
